Research has shown that 'loneliness is as harmful to our health as smoking 15 cigarettes a day' and 'in Guernsey 23% of over 65s describe themselves as feeling intensely socially lonely'. The Trinity Seniors programme plays a vital role in combating this however, we are in urgent need of people who would be willing to collect or drop off a passenger or two for some of the seniors activities. Commitment required is completely flexible and would be entirely up to you and dependant on your availability and circumstances at the time.
