

The Jesus Story in Luke's Gospel - between now and Easter in the morning services we will be looking at Luke's gospel. Luke was an educated and cultured man and the first real historian to write about Jesus. Luke was likely to have been a doctor and wrote about 25% of the New Testament in Luke and Acts. Luke himself wasn't an eye witness to Jesus but he was probably a companion to Paul, talked to various people involved with Jesus, read some earlier writings and then wrote quite a full version of the Jesus story.

The gospel of Luke is for **everyone** - why not read it through a couple of times over these next few months by reading a chapter a day?

When the children leave the main service they will meet in Room 1 for a Kids Service, families are welcome to join their children for this. Creche will remain in Room 1.

After the teaching the children will have the opportunity to choose activities in three different groups; Active, Create and Engage.

The 'Active' room (Room 2) provides children with a chance to burn off some Sunday morning energy by taking part in energetic, run around games and learn more about the morning's theme by getting active. For children who like to get their creative juices flowing, the morning's theme is explored through arts, craft and other creative mediums in the 'Create' room (Room 3). Digging a bit deeper, the 'Engage' room (Room 5) gives children the opportunity to delve into the morning's teaching in an interactive and immersive way.

Years 7 to 9 will meet in the Youth Room (Room 4) as soon as they leave the service as usual.
