This would be mainly on a Wednesday for the lunches at church or on a Monday afternoon for the small group meetings.

Café Team – we are looking for extra helpers in the café from September. There are a variety of ways in which you could help –

Being part of the Kitchen team – preparing, dish-washing, clearing
Barrista – train up to use the coffee machine
